

Project update – Work resuming at the intersection of Bells Line of Road and Grose Vale Road/Terrace Road, North Richmond from Monday 23 October

The Australian and NSW Governments have committed \$18 million to improve traffic conditions at key intersections on Kurrajong Road, March Street and Bells Line of Road, on approach to Richmond Bridge.

Roads and Maritime Services is delivering this project, which involves improving the intersection of Bells Line of Road/Terrace Road and Grose Vale Road, North Richmond.

The project will improve travel times and traffic flows during peak periods.

Progress so far and the next stage

We have surveyed the site and identified the location of utilities. The work still to be done includes:

- property adjustments
- removing some vegetation
- relocating utilities
- installing or improving dedicated turning lanes on all sides of the intersection
- providing two westbound lanes from Pitt Lane to approximately 90 metres west of Grose Vale Road
- removing about 21 parking spaces and relocating bus zones
- installing seven 15 minute parking spaces on the eastbound side of Bells Line of Road to offset the removal of longer term parking necessary for the improvement of the intersection.

Our work schedule

We will be back onsite to complete the second stage of work for another **36 night shifts** and **45 day shifts** between **Monday 23 October** and **Friday 22 December**, weather permitting. Our night work hours will be between **7pm** and **7am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**. Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **7pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and between **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturdays**.

During the early stages of work, you will notice that the project team will not be onsite at all times. This is due to ongoing utility and property adjustment design work.

We have included a map to show the location of the work.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will continue to do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **midnight** and staging them in different locations.

The service road will remain operational during this stage of work and there will be no changes to parking. We will notify the community again of any changes.

Traffic changes

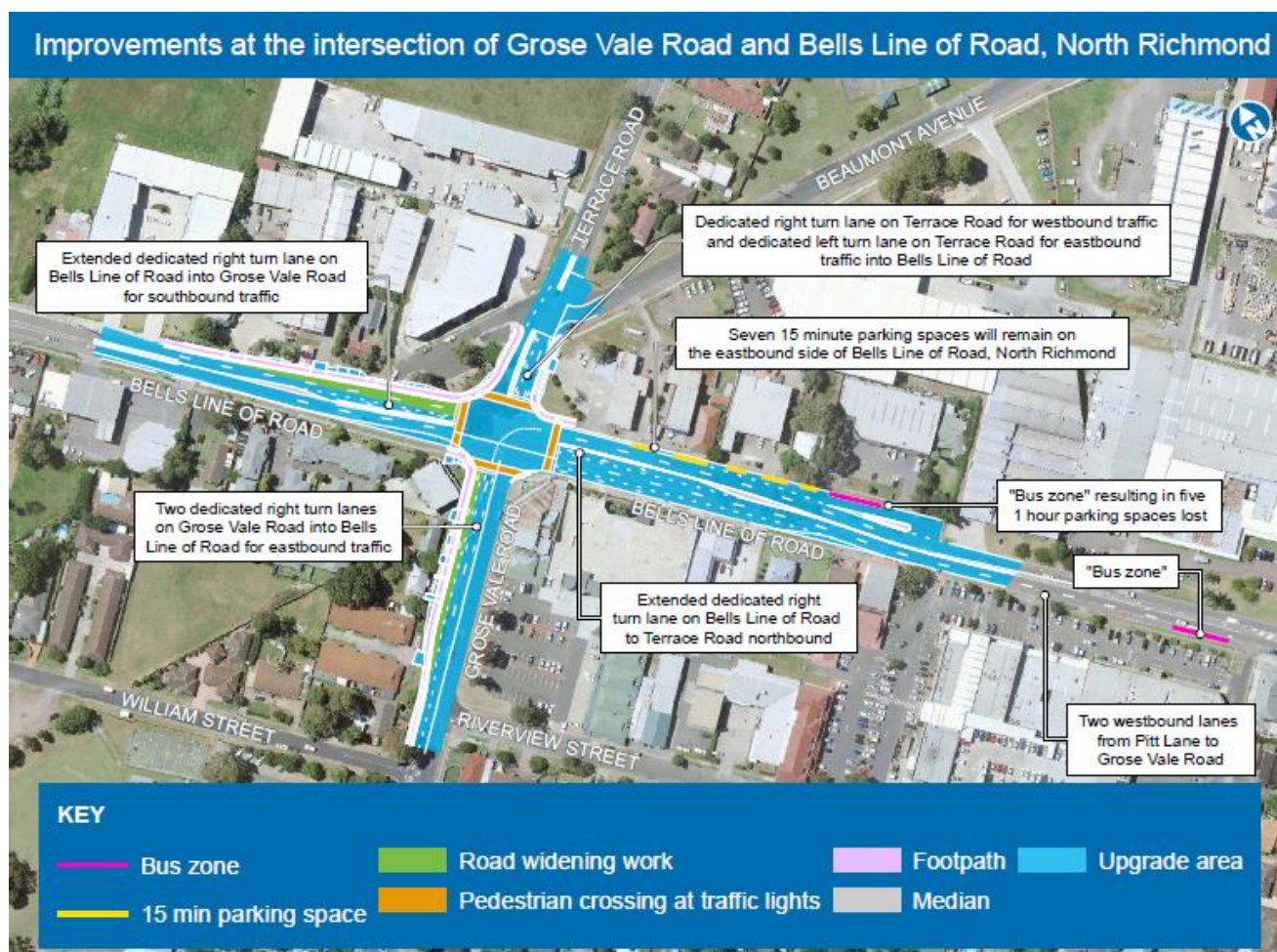
