Asbestos removal on Bells Line of Road, North Richmond from Tuesday 4 September

The Australian and NSW Governments have committed \$18 million to improve traffic conditions in the Richmond area.

Roads and Maritime Services is delivering upgrades to key intersections along the Bells Line of Road corridor to reduce congestion and improve safety. As part of this project Roads and Maritime has identified unbonded asbestos on Bells Line of Road, near Terrace Road, North Richmond

We are implementing an asbestos management plan that details safe work practices and will ensure it is managed to strict Environment Protection Authority requirements. The asbestos will be safely removed to ensure there is no risk to the public.

Our work schedule

We will carry out work to remove the asbestos over **six shifts**, between **Wednesday 5 September** and **Friday 14 September**, weather permitting.

Our work hours will be from **7am** to **5pm** on **weekdays** and **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturdays**.

Traffic changes


There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
