

## Asbestos removal on Bells Line of Road, Grose Vale Road and Terrace Road, North Richmond from 9 October

The Australian and NSW Governments have committed \$18 million to improve traffic conditions in the Richmond area.

Roads and Maritime Services is delivering the Richmond Intersection Improvements project and has identified some further bonded asbestos along parts of Bells Line of Road, Terrace Road and Grose Vale Road.

We are implementing an asbestos management plan that details safe work practices and will ensure it is managed to strict Environment Protection Authority requirements. The asbestos will be safely removed to ensure there is no risk to the public.

### Our work schedule

We will carry out work to remove the asbestos over between **Tuesday 9 October** and **Friday 30 November**, weather permitting.

Our work hours will be from **7am** to **5pm** on **weekdays** and **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturdays**.


### Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
